The August meeting for NNIC was held in Carson City and was a opportunity for everyone to network and create an open discussion about immunization trends and outreach efforts to improve Nevada rates.

Prior to the open discussion the following topics where briefly discussed:

### **Funding:**

The base grant for state funding is in place at \$120,000 above and over that been raised. NNIC is also continuing to apply for additional grants to help fund school and community clinics. As that information becomes available, we will provide an update.

### **School Clinics:**

NNIC is targeting the Douglas, Carson City, Washoe, Elko and Lyon counties for school clinics. The new hire, Tina Vesely will be heading up those clinics. We have decided to provide donation envelopes to the families whose children receive immunizations as a way to raise extra money. This was tested during the Tdap pilot project and about \$100 was raised.

### **Flu:**

Pharmacies in the area have this season's flu vaccine. However, the state is still waiting to receive their supply as it continues to trickle in. The Washoe County Health District has private flu, but is still waiting to receive VFC.

### **Tdap:**

Washoe County Schools are starting in less than a week and there are still hundreds of 7<sup>th</sup> graders who are not immunized. Currently there is a report of WebIZ and Infinite Campus to see if there is a disconnect between immunized kids and the reported information. There will be NO extension for children not in compliance and they will be sent home from school.
