## Access to Vaccines

Immunize Nevada provided free access to over 4,200 doses of recommended vaccines to Nevadans of all ages at community and school-based clinics, health fairs, and events.



## Honoring Health Heroes

Celebrating our coalition champions is key to sustaining immunization success. Immunize Nevada recognized 125 Silver Syringe Award winners for their outstanding immunization and health achievements.



## Advocate and Collaborate

Immunize Nevada's programs connected with over 155 organizational partners, public health clinics, hospitals, schools, corporate sponsors, and grantors to increase child, teen, and adult immunization rates.

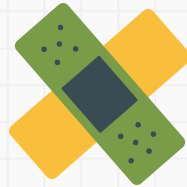


## The Future of Public Health

Immunize Nevada mentored the next generation by hosting 26 interns from University of Nevada, Las Vegas; University of Nevada, Reno; and Arizona College of Nursing. Our Healthy Young NV Youth Advisory Committee includes more than 40 Las Vegas and Reno high school and college-aged members.

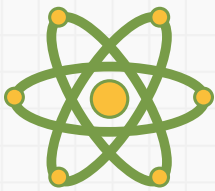
## Team Vaccine

Immunize Nevada became one of six Nevada nonprofits to receive Service Enterprise certification. Volunteers logged almost 4,500 hours promoting health and preventing disease for an estimated value of \$97,888.



## Communicating Science

In an era of misinformation, Immunize Nevada is a trusted resource for credible vaccine and preventive health news and information. Our social media messaging reached almost 1.5 million users and our TV/Radio spots aired an estimated 13,000 times. We had thousands of face-to-face conversations at over 150 statewide outreach events, and parents of more than 35,000 new babies received our Protect and Immunize Nevada's Kids packet before leaving the hospital.



## Nevada Immunization Learning Exchange (NILE)

Almost 1,500 healthcare professionals attended Immunize Nevada's monthly webinars, the Annual Nevada Health Conference, and community immunization learning series presentations.
