



# VACCINES FOR THOSE ENTERING NEVADA UNIVERSITIES

**IF YOU'RE HEADING TO COLLEGE**, it's time to think about your school vaccines. Now is the time to establish a primary care provider and schedule an appointment to get up to date on school vaccinations.

Required & Recommended Vaccines:			
<b>Tetanus &amp; Diphtheria</b> (TD or Tdap)*	<b>Measles, Mumps, &amp; Rubella</b> (MMR)*	<b>MenACWY</b> (Menactra, Menveo or MCV4)* for those enrolling before age 23 (must have been given at age 16+)	<b>Flu</b> (Annually)
<b>Human papillomavirus</b> (HPV)	<b>Meningitis B</b> (MenB)	<b>COVID-19</b> (Pfizer for those under 18, Moderna or Janssen for 18+)	

**NEVADA LAW REQUIRES CERTAIN IMMUNIZATIONS** (those marked \*) for university entry – unless exempt due to a medical condition or religious belief. Other listed vaccines are recommended for college-aged students to help ensure good health.

**WORRIED ABOUT PAYING FOR VACCINES?** Many Nevada healthcare providers offer vaccines at low or no cost to parents as part of the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program (Younger than 19 years of age).
