Vaccination is one of the best protections from diseases that can be very serious, may require hospitalization, or even be deadly.

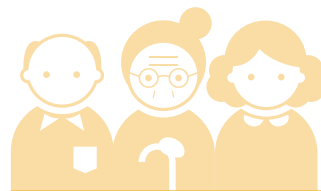


ADOLESCENCE & EARLY/MID ADULT
