Data Quality & Public Health

- Impact on patient care and providers
 - Prevents duplicate immunization records
 - Additional data that can be helpful:
 - Documented allergies/risks
 - Adverse reactions to previous doses
 - Documented vaccine refusals
 - Patient notes


- Impact on community
 - Public Health Preparedness
 - Vaccine recalls
 - Perinatal Hepatitis B Prevention
- Impact on our state
 - National Immunization Rates improved
 - Determine areas/communities of need
 - Accurate Data means better funding!

Accurate Data In Action

- "Check Before You Inject"
 - 20% of Clark County school children who attended Back to School Clinics did not need immunizations

Accurate Data In Action • View Only Access - Schools/childcare providers verify records - Large athletic club with onsite daycare • 5 man hours a week saved with NV WebIZ training • HL7 Applicants - Required to correct and maintain accurate data before electronic submission approved

Accurate Data In Action

- VFC Providers
 - Required VFC reports queried and submitted using NV WebIZ
 - Non-profit clinic started using Type 3 Inventory Access to save time, paper, and labor

Divide and Conquer



- Develop Workflow Practices
 - Receptionist look-up record, verify demographical data, VFC status, print recommender
 - Medical Assistant enter administered IZ into NV WebIZ
 - Back-office staff enter historical data
 - Check-out staff print Official Record, give to patient with next appointment date

Divide and Conquer

- Develop Policies and Procedures defined by position and include NV WebIZ duties to employee's Work Performance Standards for the position
- Designate a person to receive and manage physical vaccine inventory in your refrigerator and in NV WebIZ - along with a backup person

Sharing Best Practices

- Implementing Divide and Conquer ideas
 - LV Pediatrician, 1 Dr., 1 office, 3,340+ vaccines/3 months
 - LV Pediatrician, 1 Dr., 1 office (New), 556 vaccines/3 months LV Pediatrician, 9 Drs., 2 offices, 12,000+ vaccines/3 months
- Your Office?
- What are you doing now?
- What will you do in the future?

Sharing Best Practices

- If no EMR can use NV WebIZ as your immunization database
- If EMR and NV WebIZ are up-to-date, enroll in HL7 process
- Don't want duplicate entry some just use NV WebIZ as their EMR's vaccine module

Accurate Data = More \$

- Prepare to extract quality Reminder/Recalls from NV WebIZ by keeping Patient Roster up-to-date
- Knowing the number of vaccines needed for patients can prevent over-ordering and under-ordering

Accurate Data = More \$

- Learn which reports can help with budget planning
- Pharmaceutical/Vaccine Manufacturers are paying for Reminder/Recalls = upload data from NV WebIZ to their services and they pay for printing / postage / phone calls

Special Event Reporting

- Benefits of a separate 'clinic' location such as Flu, Special Events, Offsite
- Affects on Patient Roster




Special Event Reporting
